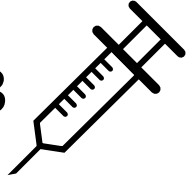


# 1 Year Vaccines



## 1 Pneu-C-13



**This vaccine protects against infections caused by 13 different bacteria that are the most common cause of pneumococcal disease in infants and young children in Canada**

**Pneumonia** is an infection of the lungs that can be caused by a virus or bacteria, that can be spread by coughing or sneezing. It can also be passed on surfaces. Sometimes the bacteria can cause severe ear, lung, blood or brain infections especially in those who are very young.

## 2 Men-C-C



**The meningococcal conjugate (Men-C-C) vaccine helps protect almost all children and adults from an illness called invasive meningococcal disease**

**Invasive Meningococcal disease** is a serious infection that can cause swelling of the lining of the brain and spinal cord (meningitis). This can be fatal.

## 3 MMR



**The MMR vaccine is one needle that helps to protect against three serious and contagious infections: measles, mumps and rubella, also known as German measles.**

Measles is caused by a virus and spread through talking, sneezing and coughing. This can cause pneumonia and swelling of the brain and can lead to seizures and death. Mumps is a viral infection that causes fever, headache and swelling of the salivary glands. Rubella (also known as German measles) is a viral infection that can be serious and cause blood clotting, chronic arthritis, and swelling of the brain
