

# 2 Month Vaccines



At 2 months old, your child gets 3 vaccinations.

## 1 DTap-IPV-Hib



**This vaccine protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Polio, Haemophilus influenzae type b. This is this 1st in a 4 dose series.**

### **What are these diseases?**

These diseases are caused by bacteria or viruses and can cause serious illness and potential death. It is important to get your children vaccinated against all these illnesses.

## 2 Pneu-C-13

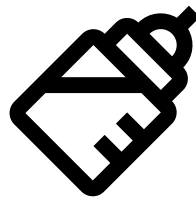


**This vaccine protects against infections caused by 13 different bacteria that are the most common cause of pneumococcal disease in infants and young children in Canada**

**Pneumonia** is an infection of the lungs that can be caused by a virus or bacteria, that can be spread by coughing or sneezing. It can also be passed on surfaces. In most people, this will not cause serious illness, but sometimes the bacteria can cause severe ear, lung, blood or brain infections especially in those who are very young.

## Rot-5/RotaRix



**This vaccination protects children from Rotavirus, and is given to children by mouth**

**Rotavirus** is a virus that can cause severe diarrhea and vomiting that affects mostly babies and young children. This can lead to serious dehydration, which if not treated, can be deadly.

### **What to expect when you come into the clinic:**

- if your child is under 1, they will receive any injections in their thigh
- You will be asked to hold the child on your lap, if you are comfortable
- If 2 nurses are available, we will try to do the vaccines at the same time, if not the vaccines will be given one at a time
- You will have to wait 15 minutes at the clinic after the vaccination
