

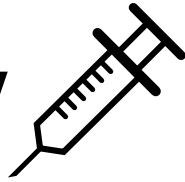
4-6 Year Vaccines

MMRV

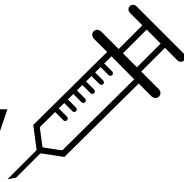


The MMRV vaccine is one needle that helps to protect against four serious and contagious infections: measles, mumps and rubella, and varicella (chicken pox)

These are all serious diseases caused by viruses and easily spread. It is important to protect your children against these.

Tdap-IPV



This vaccine protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, and Polio.

What are these diseases?

These diseases are caused by bacteria or viruses and can cause serious illness and potential death. It is important to get your children vaccinated against all these illnesses.
